

## INTERGAZ IN POLAND

### Another **Success** story

**In December 1990, Kromschroeder signed the joint-venture agreements together with PGNiG, the national oil and gas trust and with a local industrial company to build up the joint operation Intergaz in order to produce and manufacture the Kromschroeder G4 for the Polish market.**

With more than 100 employees, Intergaz has produced more than 1 million gas meters since the start of production in 1992. In 1998, Intergaz started to produce the Elster 2-stage medium pressure regulator MR10 on the basis of a licence and know-how agreement. In the middle of 2001, another milestone was set with the instal-

lation of a new assembly line for the BK2.5. The new diaphragm gas meter technology is already well accepted by the Polish customers. The market share of Intergaz in residential gas metering is already very good. The goal for regulating is to achieve a high market share with various versions of the Elster 2-stage technology for the Polish market. In addition to the existing product. Intergaz is now able to supply several new connection configurations like U-shape in-line or a new special angled version.

The executive managers, Miss Lydia Szynol and Zygmunt Traba are confident of expanding the business in the future. Marketing goals within the next years are to intensify the sales efforts and network for the total ELSTER-AMCO product portfolio.
