PTT NGD has successfully developed the natural gas supply network in the Samutprakran Industrial Estate, which includes Bang Poo, Bang Plee and Ladkrabang. The development of PTT NGD is not limited to South Bangkok, however. Recently, more areas in the northern part of the city such as the Bangkok Rangsit area and Rojana Industrial Park have been developed by PTT NGD.

In late 2001, PTT NGD managed to develop areas on the Eastern Seaboard, where the future industrial expansion will unfold. With this in mind, PTT NGD has signed a joint venture "Amata Natural Gas Distribution Co., Limited" (Amata NGD) with Amata Corporation plc and Unocal North Asean Ventures to develop 2 areas with a total equity amounting to 160 million Baht.

a fast-growing company in the oil and gas industry which provides engineering and inspection services with the support of the ELSTER-AMCO Singapore office, was awarded the 2-year contract for the design, manufacture and supply of Meter Regulating Stations (MRS) for both the PTT NGD and Amata NGD companies.

According to the contract, Synergy Supply and Services will act as an EPCC Contractor to supply various types of MRS stations ranging from 25 m³/h to 2,500 m³/h with inlet pressures varying from 5 barg to 15 barg. Synergy Supply and Services with the support from ELSTER, AMERICAN METER COMPANY, ELSTER-JEAVONS and INTERNATIONAL GAS APPARATEN B.V. managed to submit a very competitive and technically superior bid during the bidding process. With the close co-operation between the various companies and the local representatives, Synergy emerged as the most reliable and competitive bid and managed to get the approval from PTT NGD and Amata NGD as the supplier of their station requirements for the next two years.
